2017 F4 US Championship Testing Guidelines

Starting January 1, 2017, the following testing regulations will be in effect:

- Any testing at the following race tracks is prohibited.
 - Homestead Speedway
 - VIR
 - Indianapolis Motor Speedway
 - Mosport/Canadian Tire
 - Mid-Ohio
 - COTA
- Pre-season private testing is limited to 4 test events per driver
 - Test event is defined as up to 2 consecutive test days
 - A driver may test up to 8 days, not 8 events
 - Series Rookies may apply for a waiver for one additional event if the events are done with different teams
- In season private testing is limited to 5 test days per driver
 - Test day is defined as up to 8 hours on a single road course or circuit.
- Series participants may participate in any SCCA sanctioned event, excluding events located at those tracks identified above. This includes the promoter test day included in those SCCA sanctioned events. F4 is classified in full pro trim in FA per the SCCA Club Racing 2017 GCR
- The Series will host 2 test events at a location and date to be determined where an educational component would be offered to supplement the mandatory in season learning objectives.
- Teams must notify the Series of all test private test days at least 2 weeks prior to their scheduled testing. This includes any participation in a SCCA sanctioned event. This is to be done through the Series website.
- All test data must be turned into Honda per guidelines
