Understanding the ECE R22.05 certification label



05300140/P-010

- A circle surrounding the letter "E" followed by the distinguishing number of the country which has granted approval.
- The approval number (1st two digits at present "05") followed by:
- A dash and symbol:
 - o "J" if the helmet does not have a lower face cover (open face)
 - o "P" if the helmet has a protective lower face cover (full face), or
 - o "NP" if the helmet has a non-protective lower face cover.
- A dash followed by a production serial number.

This will likely be a sewn-in fabric label inside the helmet.
